

MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS FOR WOOD FENCES

- 1) All fences are required to have the Flood Plain Administrators Approval.
- 2) Compliance required for zoning (setbacks, height.)
- 3) Hole diameter is required to be 8" larger than the post (4" clearance around post.)
- 4) Hole depth is to be 42"
- 5) Place post on six inches of drain rock.
- 6) Pour concrete around post. Taper top of the concrete to drain water away from the post (see post detail.)
- 7) Wood shall be either pressure treated, redwood or cedar.
- 8) Screws shall be either galvanized, stainless steel, or weather resistant.
- 9) Post spacing is eight feet maximum.
- 10) Building permit required if fence is more than six feet tall.
