City Attorney

Ordinance 1329 – Committee recommended to full council to approve the second reading of Ordinance 1329 – An Ordinance Amending Chapter 17, Traffic and Vehicles, Article VI. Stopping, Standing and Parking of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Spearfish.
