



Spearfish Special Election Canvass Board
Special Session Minutes
October 15, 2019

The Spearfish City Council met for the Election Canvassing in the Council Chambers at City Hall at 4:58 p.m. on Tuesday, October 15, 2019 with the following members present: Clark, Eisenbraun, Hodgs, and Jacobs. Also present: City Administrator Harmon, Finance Officer DeNeui, and Finance Accountant Hafner. Council President Hodgs presided and called the meeting to order. All stood and recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Clark moved, Jacobs seconded and all voted to approve the agenda. No conflicts of interest were noted.

Finance Officer DeNeui read the returns from the County Auditor’s tabulations and the governing board was satisfied they were accurate and genuine and matched the official canvass sheet.
