



PROJECT DESCRIPTION

JACKSON BOULEVARD STREET, STORM, AND UTILITY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

PHASE 1 (3RD STREET TO 10TH STREET)

UPDATED: MARCH 14, 2019

PROJECT LOCATION & DESCRIPTION:

- **Phase 1** of the project is located from 3rd Street to 10th Street and includes underground utility improvements, converting the current 4 lane roadway to a 5 lane roadway with raised medians and center turn lanes, bike lanes from 3rd Street to Canyon Street, a raised median on Main Street from Jackson Boulevard to Kansas Street, landscaping, and lighting. **Work on this phase is scheduled to begin as soon as weather permits this spring.** Work is scheduled to be substantially complete by November 8th, 2019, with the completion of the landscaping and other miscellaneous items by June 1st of 2020.
- **Phase 2** of the project is located from University Street to 3rd Street and 10th Street to the Interstate and includes underground utility improvements, converting the current 4 lane roadway to a 3 lane roadway with raised medians and center turn lanes, a roundabout at Ames Street, protected bike lanes, landscaping, and lighting. Phase 2 is under design and is scheduled to be constructed in 2020.

TRAFFIC CONTROL AND ACCESS DURING PHASE 1:

1. Traffic on Jackson Boulevard will be reduced to one lane each direction during construction.
2. Expect lane closures at times on Main Street 1 block north and south of Jackson Boulevard during portions of construction.
3. The signals at Main Street and at Canyon Street will be disabled at times and a 4-way stop will be in place during portions of construction.
4. Turn lanes at the Jackson and Main Intersection will be maintained during most of the project, but will be closed at times during portions of construction.
5. Up to 2 side streets may be closed at any one time during the project.
6. **Access to businesses and homes** shall be maintained at all times. Providing alternate access is permitted. Locations with multiple accesses may be reduced to one access. The contractor will coordinate/notify landowners of any alterations to their access.
7. Jackson Boulevard will be permitted to be closed from Meier Avenue to 3rd Street with traffic detoured over the Grant Street Bridge for a maximum of 14 days to complete the installation of underground utilities.
8. Jackson Boulevard will be permitted to be reduced to one westbound lane from Main Street to 7th Street with eastbound traffic detoured to Illinois Street for a maximum of 4 days to complete the installation of underground utilities.
